Pedagogical Evangelism: how to make disciples who make disciples

COURSE DESCRIPTION

How does one church in SE Asia see 1,700,000 baptisms in from 2001-2011? How does one lady in Guatemala (Sister Laura) see seventy ladies come to Christ in a prison ministry and began reproducing a period of months? This course studies the Biblical principles used in foreign mission work and how they can be used here in our CVBA area.

I. Required text purchases

Brock, Charles. *Indigenous Church Planting, a Practical Journey*
(available from CVBA office @ \$10)

(Other course material provided by the CVBA will be mailed to you by your prof: these are from our IMB and also the Missions Frontiers ministry center)

II. Course assignments and requirements

- a. Textbook readings and reports on each week's assigned pages of text (you will read approximately seventy-five pages per week which includes the textbook and other source materials sent you by your prof)
- b. Weekly reports on the readings which develop your understanding of how to do the work of making disciples which make disciples.
- c. Discussion Board forums (6)

Six Discussion Board forums (weeks 2-7) addressing a topic posted by the prof based upon that week's reading assignments. The main posting **must be between 100 and 150 words** and must be completed no later than Thursday evening of the week in which the forum is assigned. The student will then reply to at least two other classmate's threads. **Each reply must not exceed seventy-five words** and be submitted no later than Sunday evening of each week. The prof will explain how this Discussion Board assignment works through using Facebook. All you need is to establish an account on Facebook.

d. Term Project

The project is to make a plan with another person in your church to start a new Bible group with unbelievers. You will give a two page on how you will go about doing this and the plan of when you will do this work.
